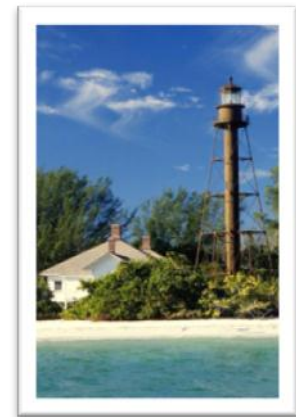
Sanibel and Captiva Islands – Short Introduction
